Harvest Assembly

Reverend Shaw will be coming into school next week to take part in our Harvest Assembly. Every year Rev Shaw talks to the children about ways in which we can support our sister school (St Clement's) in Kenya. In past years we have sent out uniform and raised money for porridge which the children have when they arrive at school. This year Revd Shaw is trying to raise money for sewing machines so that the children and local families can learn new skills and become more independent at making and repairing their own clothes. Further details will follow on Monday about how we in Jersey can help Revd Shaw raise funds for this worthy cause.

Collaboration Day

Our first Collaboration day has been planned for Friday 20th October. Instead of short sessions of Golden Time on a weekly basis, we are trialling special days where the children get to work together and complete different activities.

Foundation Stage will spend time playing collaboratively using the indoor and outside space.

Key Stage 1 will 'Reach for the Stars' and combine classes to work in groups for some collaborative activities. There will be a particular focus on Art and Dance.

Key Stage 2 will split into mixed age groups across their house groups for the morning. They will all complete four different activities, to include both physical and mental collaborative challenges, as well as some cooking. In the afternoon the children will spend time back in class groups before meeting as a group to conclude the day.

If any parents are available to help with activities during the morning session, please let your child's class teacher know.

All children from Reception –Year 6 to come to school in PE kit on that day please. Any children who wish to add an accessory in their house colours are very welcome. (socks, hairbands, wristbands etc.) Please no face/ hair paint!

INSET Day in May, 2018

During the school year teachers have three designated INSET training days. The first of these is the very first day of school in September. The second is Battle of Britain day, usually around the middle of September. The final day has historically been the day before the beginning of the Summer Term.

The Education Department has recently given permission for schools to be more flexible with the timing of this last day and so next year I have made a change.

In 2018, Monday 7th May is a Bank Holiday and Wednesday 9th May is also a holiday for Liberation Day. I have therefore arranged for our final INSET day to be on Tuesday 8th May, 2018. This will mean two things:

- The children and staff will all return to school on Monday 16th April to begin the Summer Term.
- Families will be able to have a long five day weekend from Saturday 5th May to Wednesday 9th May.

I will send out a reminder in the New Year about these arrangements, but just wanted parents to be aware of this in case they wanted to book a flight or ferry for an off island break.

Morning Drop Off Reminder

Please could parents not let their children out of their car until they have stopped in the coned drop off area being monitored by Mr Mildren and Miss Andrews. This is for the children's safety.
