Our JP children were prioritised to attend our School Provision during Lockdown. If they did not attend regular phone calls were made by SLT and the class teachers to touch base with the children and their families.

Aim: Provide the highest quality teaching in all our classes. Activity: To use our updated Teaching and Learning policy to inform our planning and to monitor teaching. Cost: £2,000	The new policy was referred to by all class teachers for planning and it was used during learning walk and lesson observations as a monitoring tool.
Project and Rationale	Impact
Aim: Provide the highest quality teaching in all our classes. Activity: We are going to employ an extra, experienced Foundation Stage Teacher for the mornings of the spring and summer term to develop spoken language skills outside and in our Forest School. Staff Costs: £15,500 Small World Play resources £ 700 Nature Garden Infrastructure £2,500	The Nature School has now been created and is used by classes from nursery to Year 6 to enhance curriculum provision. This includes a sensory area and small world area that children use for imaginative play.

Extra staffing allows for more time to be used for high quality observations for 'focus' children and allows for various types of intervention to take place. These may include: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attending Morning and After School club. • Ensuring all children who audition for our school production are given the opportunity to participate. • Ensuring that all children have an opportunity to represent the school in our sports teams if they attend practises. <p>Ensuring that all children are encouraged to put themselves forward to be a Class Council Representative.</p> <p>Cost: Cost neutral</p>	<p>Unfortunately, there were limited opportunities re. enrichment opportunities this year due to the School Safety Plan which has been put in place due to the pandemic. However, we continue to monitor activities such as Rights Respecting School Ambassador elections, our Reward System etc. and each year we are making improvements regarding the percentage of JP children being successful in these activities.</p>
