Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
Aim: Provide the highest quality teaching in all our classes. Activity: To employ an extra teacher to work in each class, from Year 1 to Year 6 for one morning a week to Team Teach with the class teacher, focusing on up levelling writing.	To teach pupils how to up level their own writing so that the children can improve and make progress in their writing. This skill will be learnt in their literacy work, but it will be transferred to their cross curricular writing.

Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
 Aim: Provide the highest quality teaching in all our classes. Activity: To continue to employ an extra Teaching Assistant for afternoons in our KS2 classes so that higher quality interactions can take place. Extra staffing allows for more time to be used for high quality observations for 'focus' children and allows for various types of interventions to take place. Cost: £ 5 000 	The class teachers will be able to plan targeted interventions based upon formative assessment and observations. This will facilitate explaining any misconceptions or filling any gaps so that children can move on to the next step in their learning.
Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
Aim: Provide the highest quality teaching in all our classes. Activity-For teachers to plan for challenge, using a Coaching Model approach.	To challenge pupils so that the % number of pupils, across all year groups, that are working at secure levels in Reading, Writing and Maths is in line with our statistical neighbours

Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
 Aim: Develop children's communication, language, and literacy Activity: We will introduce the WellComm programme into our Foundation Stage. We will assess all the children and identify and teach their next steps through play-based activities. Cost: £1 000 	To develop the language skills of all the children in the Foundation Stage. This will have a positive effect on their learning, as well as specifically developing literacy, social and emotional development.
Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
Aim: Develop children's communication, language, and literacy Activity- We will continue to use volunteers from ECOF (Every Child Our Future) to regularly listen to the children in our KS1 classes who are just behind their age-related level in reading Cost: Cost neutral	The reading levels at the end of Key Stage 1 will be in line with our statistical neighbours. All children in Year 2 will be working at the expected level for their year group. The children's confidence and engagement in reading will improve.

Wider Strategies

Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
 Aim: Develop children's communication, language, and literacy Activity- Each term we will organise a Progress Meeting for each class teacher in our school, from Nursery to year 6. During these meetings we will discuss the communication, language and literacy needs of all our children in the school. We will also have a specific focus on our Jersey Premium children. We will respond to individual and group needs in a variety of ways, including: - 1-1 SALT support Language intervention groups Phonics intervention groups Boosting Reading @ Primary intervention programme Five Minute box Buying engaging readers for our school library and book corners Cost: £1 000 	Each class teacher will be aware of the needs, barriers and next steps for all of the children in their class. SLT and class teachers will problem solve how to plan for progress for all children in the class.

Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
Aim: Develop children's communication, language, and literacyActivity-To run a facility at lunch time for children to attend who are unable to do their homework at home.Cost: £2 000	All children can complete any homework activity that is set for them, either in school or at home.
Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
 Aim: Use data and our knowledge of pupils to identify individual barriers to learning Activity: Throughout the year, we will continue to update our Jersey Premium Audit Tool so that we can gather information and identify possible barriers to learning. We will then plan a variety of responses based upon the identified need; these will include: - Providing resources and advice for take home tasks Provision of extra reading books Signposting parents to our Parent Drop In sessions Sharing specific emotional needs of children at our weekly briefings so that the whole school community can lookout and support these children ELSA and Well Being intervention programmes. 	The tool is updated and referred to throughout the year. Teachers will use the tool so that an in depth understanding of the student can be gleaned and used to lift any barriers to learning.
Project and Rationale	Expected Outcome
Aim: Provide social and emotional support for identified pupils Activity- We will continue to fund for an extra member of staff to cover our 3 ELSA trained members of staff to deliver an emotional literacy programme to identified children in school. We will continue to resource our 'Quiet Place' so that the needs of all the children who visit and learn there are met. Cost £1,000	To support children in school so that they understand and regulate their own emotions, learn to respect themselves and others around them and develop their personal resiliency. This will then have a positive impact on the development of their learning traits and on their academic progress.
